LAST STEPS THAT SHOULD BE FIRST

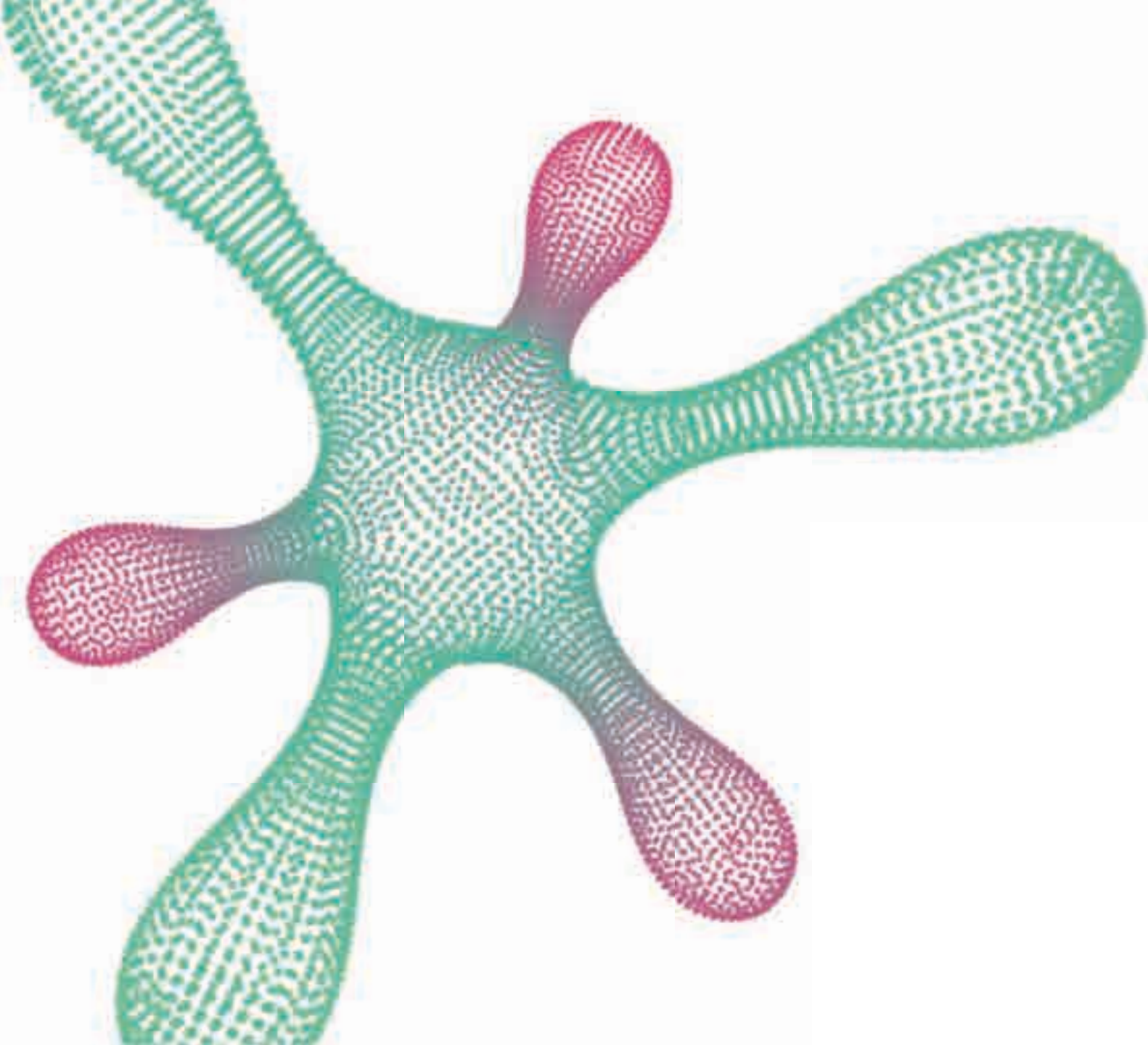
- Get recommenders

Graduate and Undergraduate Process



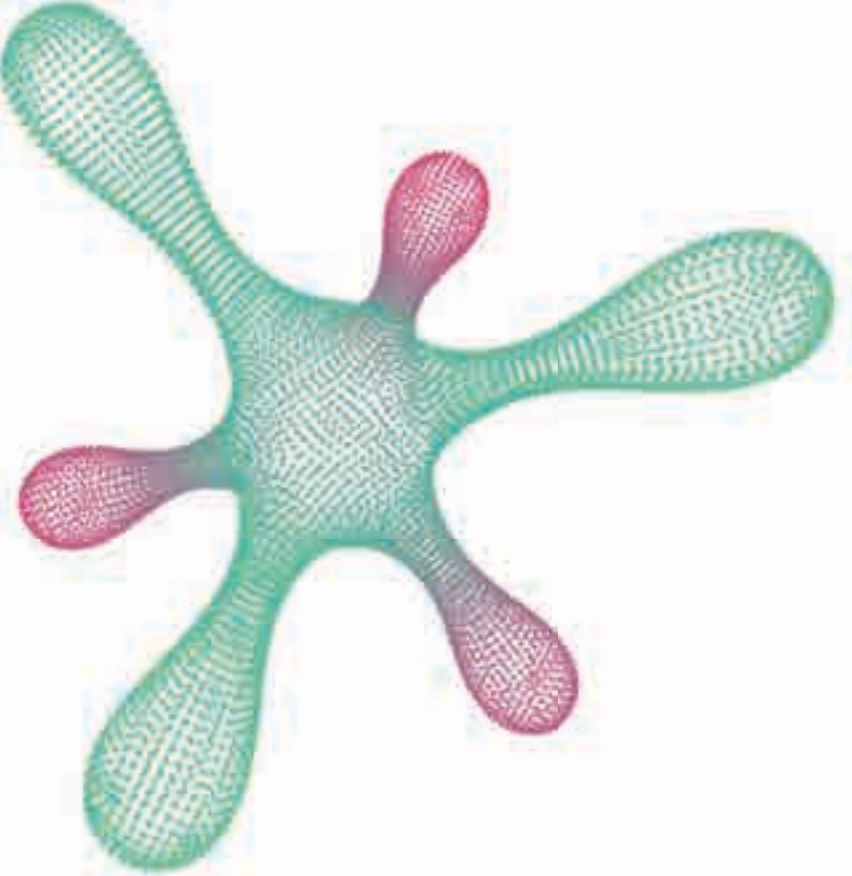
2 volunteers

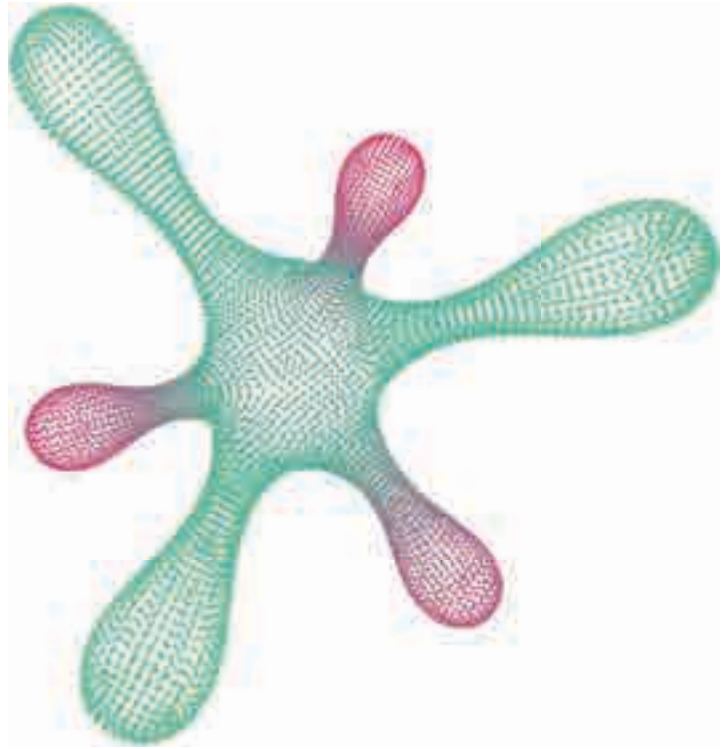
