

# A MESSAGE FROM THE DEAN

Storytelling is ancient. Whether keeping history alive, holding up a mirror to our lives, or sharing our deepest secrets, storytelling is as fundamental a force of nature as fire or water. The power of storytelling is abundantly evident in the over 110 films, videos, multimedia, and animation pieces included in the 64th First Run Festival presented by the Kanbar Institute of Film and Television at New York University. What these cinematic expressions demonstrate is that even in this era of technological change, when old mediums converge and new mediums seem to emerge overnight, even with the remarkable range of genres and stylistic approaches to the medium, the single most compelling constant is the urge to present a well-told story. Our congratulations go out to each and every one of our filmmakers in the festival for their energy, imagination, and collaborative spirit.

Good stories have long lifetimes and so it is with the films that debut at the First Run Festival. Many of these works go on to screenings at international film festivals, cable television, Sundance, and internet sites. Since 1992, our students have won 15 gold Student Academy Awards for their films from the prestigious Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. At the 2005 & 2006 Sundance Film Festivals, Tisch filmmakers walked away with a total ten prizes.

Wherever the films are screened, they have always benefited from enthusiastic audiences. Audiences for First Run are as much a part of the festival as the films themselves, and we are pleased to welcome members of the general public, industry professionals, as well as our colleagues and friends from the NYU community. This year, the Charles & Lucille King Family Foundation has once again generously underwritten a special grant to be awarded to the top three prizes in each of the graduate and undergraduate departments and has also supported the King Awards for best screenwriting during this year's Wasserman Ceremony. We are most grateful for this enthusiastic support of our young filmmakers.

A special word of thanks once again to Maurice Kanbar whose naming gift to the NYU film program created the Kanbar Institute of Film and Television. He has been mentor, supporter, and, with his creative energy, and masterful skill as a film producer, an example of bold, innovative thinking for our young artists. We are deeply grateful for his support.

## MEET THE GRADUATE FINALISTS

## MICHAEL BROWN

His first was Vitamina, a documentary shot in Cuba about a church-run residence for the elderly. Nicotás was born and raised in Miami, Florida. His father is Cuban artist Humberto Calzada. In 2002 he graduated from Yale University with a BA in History. He is currently writing his thesis script as well as a feature script, inspired by his father's morning routine, about the regulars of a Cuban bakery who must find a new reason to get up in the morning. -and live- when they are banned from their daily breakfast stop.

## JUAN CASTILO

Originally from rural Dominican Republic, Juan grew up in Brooklyn. He has written three feature scripts: Sanjas, winner of the ABC Talent Development grant, about a boy, his mule and globalization; Batey Felicidad, winner of the Latino Public Broadcasting/ PBS development grant, about a guy, his grandma and fundamental human rights; and the feature length extension of Secuestro, Low-Hanging Juicy Fruit, about three rookie kidnappers, their big mistake and a raging peasant lynch mob.

## RAFAEL DEL TORO

Rafael is a product of New York University's Graduate Film Program, His awards and recognitions include a Student Academy Award Nomination, a Coca-Cola Refreshing Filmmaker's Award, and a Sloan Foundation Screenwriting Award, His films have been screened in festivals worldwide. His upcoming projects include "Mullet," a feature film based on the comedy style. that won him acclaim in his short film, "6ft, in 7min.".

#### GRANT GREENBERG

Born and raised in South Africa, Grant directed television before leaving his homeland for New York City, He has received grants from the National Film and Video Foundation of South Africa and won a VUKA award for a series of public service. announcements. His short documentary, "The Fizz," was selected as a national finalist in the Student Academy Awards and was an official selection of the Berlin International Short Film Festival.
